It is important for students to choose somewhere to stay before arriving in the UK and our Housing Officer can advise on finding the best kind of accommodation to suit each student's requirements.

### // Accommodation

Most students choose from homestay, residential, private accommodation or a hotel/bed and breakfast. WE Bridge Academy homestay accommodation availability is limited and must be booked at least two weeks before arrival (subject to availability).

We understand how important it is to secure the right accommodation and we ensure that our extensive network of homestay providers offers accommodation that is pleasant, comfortable and safe.

Our English-speaking hosts provide an opportunity to practise English language skills.

A single room on a half-board basis with breakfast and evening meal.

A single room on a full-board basis for students aged under 18.

Each home is inspected to meet British Council quality standards.

A maximum of one student per nationality will be placed in each home.

A payment for the first 4 weeks accommodation is required to secure homestay.

Our Housing Officer will provide students with all the information needed prior to their arrival in the UK and if they have any questions regarding homestay accommodation during their stay we are always happy to help.

In order to secure homestay accommodation we have devised the following checklist:

- 1. The form must be completed at least two weeks before students arrive in the UK.
- 2. Homestay accommodation cannot be booked without a completed form.
- 3. Homestay fees are payable in addition to course fees.
- 4. Students aged under 18 must stay with a WE Bridge Academy homestay provider, or with a family member with the written permission of their parent/guardian.

## Travelling to the United Kingdom

First time visitors to the UK are advised to consult the following useful websites:

Information about visas can be found at gov. uk and we advise that all students check to see if a visa is required before travelling.

#### **Airport Transfers**

An airport transfer can be requested when applying to study with us, and prior to arrival, as long as we are given at least 7 days' notice. The prices may change depending on arrival time, any airport delays and exact destination.

#### **Airports**

Most students will arrive in the UK at London Heathrow or Gatwick airport. WE Bridge Academy can offer advice on getting from the airport to Cardiff and for a fee, we can arrange a taxi transfer\*. Any students wishing to make their own way from the airport to Cardiff may find the following sites useful\*\*

- By train: National Rail
- By coach: National Express\*\* or megabus\*\*
- By taxi: Dragon\*\*

\*There may be a 'waiting charge' and car parking charges made by taxi firms if a flight is delayed.

#### **Medical Treatment**

We advise students to visit their doctor, dentist and optician before travel to ensure they are fit to do so and check to see if any vaccinations are required. If a course is less than 6 months in duration, students will receive free accident and emergency hospital treatment but will have to pay for any other medical treatment as a private patient.

#### **Travel Documents**

When travelling to the UK, students need to make sure that they have the following documents:

- A valid passport
- A visa or UK-entry clearance (non-EU students)
- Vaccination or medical certificates if required
- A letter of acceptance to study at WE Bridge Academy
- Name, address and contact details of where they will be staying in the UK
- Details of any transfers, travel documents and tickets

If the student is under 18, they will need a signed letter from their parent or guardian that gives permission for them to travel.

#### **General Travel Advice**

Students need to make sure that all their travel arrangements are booked at least 5 days in advance and confirmed with us.

### How do I apply for a course at WE Bridge Academy?

Applications can be made online using our website, through an agent or by requesting a form by emailing info@we-bridge.co.uk

### What information do you need from me when I apply?

For General English applications, we require a fully completed and signed application form along with a copy of the student's passport photo page.

For those applying for our International Foundation Programme, we will need to have a completed application form, copy of the student's passport, evidence of secondary education and IELTS. Please advise us if the student is unable to provide any of the documents requested.

For all other courses, including our Trinity CertTESOL Teacher Training Programme, our Academic team will advise as to what we require in order to process an application.

#### Can anyone study at WE Bridge Academy?

We accept students aged 16 and over. If a student applying for a course with us is under the age of 18, additional documentation will be required including a Parental Permission form.

#### Do you provide accommodation?

We are pleased to be able to offer students homestay accommodation as part of the application process. Accommodation availability may be limited, particularly during the summer months, but we will always discuss this with the student when they apply. For students over the age of 18 who wish to consider private-rented or student accommodation, our Housing Officer will be able to supply more information.

Students aged 16 and 17 are required to stay in WE Bridge Academy homestay accommodation or with a responsible family member aged over 18, with written consent from the legal parent or guardian.

### What happens once I have applied for a course?

Providing all the evidence requested is provided, the student will be issued with an offer letter to study at WE Bridge Academy. Once accepted to study, students are requested to please visit our Pre-arrival page on our website which contains useful links, including applying for a visa.

#### What time are my classes?

Your class times will vary depending on the course and number of hours you study. All classes start at 09:30 and you can view a sample timetable on the Current Students page of our website.

#### What happens on my first day?

Students are asked to arrive at the academy for 9am. The first day will be a little different from a typical day in the classroom as students will be introduced to the team and the other students, asked to complete the placement test and take part in an induction to inform students about life at WE Bridge Academy, Cardiff and the UK! Students are asked to please remember to bring their original passport, visas and travel documents with them.
